NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Town Council of the Borough of Chambersburg, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, intends to consider for adoption and to vote upon an enactment of the Ordinance summarized below at the regularly scheduled Chambersburg Town Council Meeting on October 26, 2026, at 7:00 p.m. at the Borough Office, 100 South 2nd Street Chambersburg, Pennsylvania 17201.

The title of the proposed Ordinance is **AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CHAMBERSBURG, FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ADOPTING RULES GOVERNING THE INTERCONNECTION OF LARGE LOAD CUSTOMERS WITH THE BOROUGH'S ELECTRIC SYSTEM.**
